Allen Township Trustees

May 2, 2023

The Allen Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:30 p.m. in the Allen Township Center with all members present. The minutes of April 4, 2023 were read and approved.

The Fiscal Officer presented a list of warrants and electronic payments totaling \$33,728.38. Stacy moved to pay these bills. The motion was seconded by Smith. Roll call - all yes.

Rick Hoenbrink was in attendance to point out a water well issue along TR 140. He presented a map of old abandon oil wells that riddle the area. He also provided a sample of the crude oil that is floating on top of the water in the well for his home. All of his neighbors have a similar situation. Rick has approached the City of Findlay regarding extending their water line along TR 140. He would like the Trustees to support the City of Findlay extending the water line along TR 140 in Allen Township.

The Fiscal Officer presented a Resolution prepared by the Hancock County Prosecutor's Office to place No Parking signs on the north side of Elwood Street. Stacy moved to adopt the resolution with Smith seconding. Roll call - all yes.

Fire Chief Hickman reported on the past month's activities with the fire department.

Tony Humphrey reported on road and cemetery maintenance operations.

The Trustees each gave their respective reports on the past month's activities.

Smith reported that he is in process of securing bids for replacing the HVCA systems at the Twp Center and Fire station #1.

Smith advised that he discussed the issue of placing No Trucks signs on Elwood, McKinley and Fairfield streets with Cindy Land from the prosecutor's office. She advised that enforceable no trucks signs can not be placed in that area without extensive road studies to determine the need for such action.

Flanagan reported on the Hancock County Commissioner (Russell/ Lai) annexation hearing last Tuesday that he Smith and Schimmoeller attended. The requested 138 acre annexation along I-75 (CR99 to TR101) was reduce to 73 acres along I-75 (CR99 to TR100) to avoid creating several Allen Township islands along TR100.
